



DERP Advisory Committee Election time is here. The Denver Employees Retirement Plan (DERP) is governed by a five-person Board, the members of which are appointed by the Mayor for staggered six-year terms. Additionally, there is a four-member Advisory Committee to the Retirement Board. Three members of the Advisory Committee are elected by the DERP membership for staggered three-year terms, and one member is appointed by the Career Service Board.

The candidates for 2019 may be either vested current City or DHHA employees, or retired DERP members.

Heather Britton, a member of the staff of the Office of Human Resources, appointed by the Career Service Board, to a term that will expire in June, 2020.
