



DERP Advisory Committee Election time is here!

The Denver Employees Retirement Plan (DERP) is governed by a five-person Board, the members of which are appointed by the Mayor for staggered six-year terms. Additionally, there is a four-member Advisory Committee to the Retirement Board. Three members of the Advisory Committee are elected by the DERP membership for staggered three-year terms, and one member is appointed by the Career Service Board.

Vote for up to TWO candidates, because there are two terms expiring this year.

The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to serve a three-year term. The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes, who meets the qualifications of the position, will be elected to serve until May, 2019. The winners will be announced at the Annual Board meeting on May 18, 2018.
