

## DERP Advisory Committee Election time is here!



The Denver Employees Retirement Plan (DERP) is governed by a five-person Board, the members of which are appointed by the Mayor for staggered six-year terms. Additionally, there is a four-member Advisory Committee to the Retirement Board. Three members of the Advisory Committee are elected by the DERP membership for staggered three-year terms, and one member is appointed by the Career Service Board.

The current Advisory Committee is comprised of the following individuals:

**Mike Aleksick**, an elected current employee member whose term will expire in June, 2021.

**Frank T. Fresquez**, an elected retired member whose term will expire in June, 2019.

**Robert Press**, an elected retired member whose term will expire in June, 2020.

**Heather Britton**, a member of the staff of the Office of Human Resources, appointed by the Career Service Board, to a term that will expire in June, 2020.
