

Executive Director to Retire Nov. 1, 2019

Steve Hutt, Executive Director of the Denver Employees Retirement Plan (DERP), has notified the Retirement Board of his decision to retire as of Nov. 1, 2019 - - the date upon which he will complete 35 years of consecutive service in Denver city government.

Hutt began his association with DERP while he was the Denver City Treasurer, when he was appointed to the Retirement Board in 1998 by Mayor Wellington Webb. In 2004, he was named DERP's Executive Director.

Retirement Board Chair Eric Rothaus stated, "It's impossible to overstate how much the Board appreciates Steve's expertise, guidance, and hard work on behalf of Denver's employees and retirees. He has been tireless in his efforts. In light of the length and quality of Steve's service, his retirement is well-deserved."

Rothaus said the Retirement Board will convene later this month to begin the process of selecting Hutt's successor.
