

Mayor Michael Hancock has appointed Maurice Goodgaine to fill a vacancy on the Board of the Denver Employees Retirement Plan.

Mr. Goodgaine is a business professional with significant career experience in both the public and private sectors. He served as the Redevelopment Manager for the Denver Urban Renewal Authority (DURA) for 10 years, before moving to a career in commercial banking and insurance. His current responsibilities as Agency Manager, with Highlands Risk Management, involve handling personal and commercial insurance coverage for clients.

Mr. Goodgaine earned both a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration (Accounting) and a Master's Degree in Business from Colorado State University (CSU). He was appointed by the Governor to the Colorado State Banking Board of Commissioners, and was elected as its Chairman by his fellow commissioners.
